



Patient Appointment Guidelines

For over 25 years Cedar Point Dental has maintained a strict adherence to CDC Universal Precaution Standards. In order to continue our commitment to providing quality care in a safe environment, we have introduced new equipment into the office as well as new guidelines for our patients.

New equipment that will be in place at your next visit

1. The IQAir Health Pro Plus air purification system. These units utilize a hyperHEPA filtration system capable of filtering 99.5% of harmful particles down to 0.003 microns; **this is ten times smaller than a virus**. These units will be located in each clinical suite as well as in other locations throughout the office.
2. Ivory ReLeaf intra-oral suction system. This innovative suction device minimizes the aerosol risk during both dental and hygiene procedures.
3. Plexiglass Shields have been installed along the front desk to minimize contact between the administrative team and our patients.
4. Infrared thermometers will be used by each member of our clinical team to screen our patients before initiating any treatment.
5. All clinical staff will be wearing additional personal protection; this includes N95 masks, face shields, and protective jackets.

New patient interaction guidelines.

1. All patients are asked to review the COVID questionnaire on our website prior to their appointment. If you have a positive response to any of the questions, please contact our office immediately.
2. Patients are asked to arrive at the office as close to their appointment time as possible in order to minimize the number of patients in our reception area at any given time.
3. Patients who wish to remain in their vehicle until they are ready to be seen are asked to contact us when they arrive at the office.
4. Individuals who accompany patients to their appointments will be asked to remain in their vehicle until treatment is completed.
5. Parents of minors will be required to wear full PPE if they choose to accompany their children into the clinical suite.
6. All patients will have their temperatures taken prior to initiating any treatment.
7. Social Distancing will be maintained whenever possible.
